The time is getting closer for your child to start at Hylands. We have some fantastic things going on to help with the transition from Primary to Secondary.

Virtual Transition Activities

During the morning of Wednesday 8th July, we will be running a virtual transition morning for all the Year 6 students who are joining us in September. The morning will give the children the opportunity to log in and participate in activities we have planned as well get to see some of the staff they will meet in September. Additionally, the morning will include brief presentations from our Headteacher, Mr Parry as well as Mr Hepworth, our Pastoral Support Manager for Years 7 and 8 and myself. Following the activities we will be holding a question and answer session for the students. Attached to this letter you will find the resources that your child will require if they wish to participate as well as a timetable for the day.

In addition to the activities planned for the children, on Wednesday 8th July, we will also be running live virtual parent question and answer sessions with the primary liaison team to help answer any questions that you might have about the transition of your child(ren) to Hylands. Please note that all schools will be allocated two sessions during the day; as we are aware many parents may be working during the day we have also planned a dedicated Q&A session for those parents from 6:00 to 6:30PM on Wednesday 8th July.
