<p>The funding is being provided to support small group tuition for 16 to 19 students in English, maths, and other courses where learning has been disrupted.</p> <p>Although the actual tuition does not need to be for GCSE English or maths, the students supported all need to be those who had not achieved grade 5 or above in at least one of those subjects at this level by age 16.</p> <p>All supported students must be on a 16 to 19 study programme. The funding should be used to support the tuition activity above and beyond the programmes of education already planned for 2020 to 2021.</p> <p>Providers need to consider what will be most effective for their students, considering students' needs and local circumstances.
