Dear Parents/Carers

As we start back to school, it is important that all students attend school. We have put together some information to help you understand the current measure in place:

- Face coverings are not required in school. If your child feels safer wearing a face covering in communal areas, they may do so.
- Please continue taking the lateral flow test twice a week and reporting the result.
- If your child tests positive from a lateral flow test or has any Covid symptoms, they must self-isolate and also take a PCR test. If the result of the PCR test is negative, they may return to school. If it is positive, they must continue to self-isolate as directed by Public Health England.
- If your child needs to self-isolate and/or has a positive Covid test, please let us know by emailing uc@hylands-tkat.org
- Anyone under the age of 18 does not need to self-isolate if there is a positive case in the family. They need to take a PCR test but will be allowed to come to school. If the PCR test is positive, they will then need to self-isolate.

Please remember that years 7 and 11 start back on Monday 6th September at 8:30 and year 12 at 11:20. All other year groups are back at 8:30 on Tuesday 7th September.
